Each Eagles pilot is certificated with the Federal Aviation Administration or Transport Canada. Flights are conducted according to federal regulations and no aerobatic maneuvers will be performed. What will my pre-flight be like? First of all, your pilot will explain what you will see and do. This may include explaining how airplanes work, looking at an aeronautical chart (or map), and describing the interior of the airplane, including the instrument panel. Then comes the fun part: you get to go flying! Safety Reminders Safety is always top priority when it comes to aviation. Listen and follow instructions given by your pilot, stay away from the propellers, and stay with your pilot or ground crew at all times. What will my flight be like? You will spend about 15 to 20 minutes in the air and follow the basic steps in the flight pattern. You will experience the awesome feeling of flight that many people only dream about. Many people remember this experience for the rest of their lives. You will, too! 14

I, the individual and passenger signing this Agreement to Waive Liability, Assume Risk and Indemnify (the "Agreement"), wish to attend and participate in the Experimental Aircraft Association, Inc. ("EAA") Eagle Flights program, which includes riding in an airplane. In consideration for being allowed to take part in the Eagle Flights program, I agree sollows:

I am aware of and understand the following:

- I. The Eagle Flights program is conducted by volunteer, non-professional pilots who are licensed by the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") or Transport Canada ("TC"). These volunteer pilots fity a wide variety of aircraft that are also licensed by the FAA or TC. I have been provided the opportunity to evaluate the airplane and pilot and I have determined that both are fit for flight.
- 2. Flying in airplanes and being around airplanes involves risks. Serious injury or death can result from many causes, including without limitation airplane crashes, falls, pilot error, ground crew error, engine or mechanical failure, negligent maintenance, defects in runways, interference by wildlife and other objects, difficult search and rescue conditions, inadequate emergency response, weather or terrain conditions, contaminated fuel, or hard or forced landings. I am at least 18 years old (or, 19 years old if a resident of Alabama or Nebraska, 21 years old if a resident of Mississippi) and know how to read and understand the English language sufficiently to fully understand this Agreement and to appreciate its nature and consequences. If an accident were to occur then, by signing this Agreement, you would be <u>voluntarily giving up legal rights</u> and providing an unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law. If any part of this Agreement is held invalid, the rest of the provisions shall remain in effect. If you do not understand anything in this Agreement, you should <u>NOT</u> sign it.


